Legislation



REGULATION (EU) 2016/429 OF THE EUROPEAN
 PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on transmissible animal diseases and amending and repealing certain acts in the area of animal health ('Animal Health Law')



Legislation



 Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 as regards rules for the prevention and control of certain listed diseases

Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - A category



- Investigation on event of he suspicion
- Preliminary measures in case of suspicion
- Obligation of the operators in case of suspicion
- Extension of the measures depend on the reviewed by the competent authority, as appropriate, following the findings of:
 - the results of the investigation;
 - the results of the epidemiological enquiry
- further extended to other locations, where necessary



Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - Epidemiological enquiry



- The epidemiological enquiry shall aim to:
- identify the likely origin of the listed disease in question and the means of its spread;
- calculate the likely length of time that the listed disease has been present;
- identify establishments and epidemiological units therein, or other locations, where animals of listed species may have become infected, infested or contaminated;
- obtain information on the movements of kept animals, persons, products, vehicles, any material or other means by which the disease agent could have been spread during the relevant period preceding the notification of the suspicion or confirmation of the listed disease;
- obtain information on the likely spread of the listed disease in the surrounding environment, including the presence and distribution of disease vectors.

Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - Official confirmation



- The CA shall base an official confirmation on the following information:
 - the results of the clinical and laboratory examinations;
 - the preliminary or final results of the epidemiological enquiry;
 - other available epidemiological data.
- The measures continue to apply until the presence has been ruled out



Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - disease control measures



- Immediate measures by the CA:
 - declare the affected establishment, food or feed business, animal by—products establishment or other location as officially infected with that listed disease;
 - establish a restricted zone appropriate for that listed disease;
 - **implement the contingency plan** to ensure full coordination of the disease control measures.





Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - other control measures



- Measures on the affected establishments
- Restriction of movement
- Killing and removal
- Destruction of products and other materials
- Vaccination
- Isolation and treatment
- Cleaning and disinfection
- Sampling
- Laboratory examination
- Depending on the disease profile and the type of production
- Obligation of operators

Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - Other control measures



- Measures on the epidemiologically linked establishments and locations
- Establishment of restriction zones
 - the disease profile;
 - the geographical situation of the restricted zone;
 - the ecological and hydrological factors of the restricted zone;
 - the meteorological conditions;
 - the presence, distribution and type of vectors in the restricted zone;
 - the results of the epidemiological enquiry and other studies carried out and epidemiological data;
 - the results of laboratory tests;
 - the disease control measures applied;
 - other relevant epidemiological factors.



Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - measures in zones




- the identification of establishments;
- visits to establishments;
- the imposition of conditions for the movement of persons, animals, products, feed, vehicles and any other material or substance;
- biosecurity requirements for:
 - the production, processing and distribution of products of animal origin;
 - the collection and disposal of animal by-products;
 - the collection, storage and handling of germinal products;

- the vaccination and treatment
- cleaning, disinfection, control of insects and rodents;
- the designation or where relevant, approval of a food business establishment;
- the identification and traceability requirements for the movement of animals, germinal products or products of animal origin;
- other necessary biosecurity and risk-mitigating measures to minimise the risk of the spread of that listed disease.

Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - other measures



- Duration of measures
- Emergency vaccination
 - Vaccination plan
 - Vaccination zone
- Measures in wild animals
- Additional measures





Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - B and C Category



- Investigation on event of he suspicion
- Preliminary measures in case of suspicion
- Obligation of the operators in case of suspicion
- Extension of the measures depend on the reviewed by the competent authority, as appropriate, following the findings of:
 - the results of the investigation;
 - the results of the epidemiological enquiry
- further extended to other locations, where necessary



Regulation (EU) 2016/429 – control measures



- Category B
- apply the disease control measures laid down in the compulsory eradication programme for that listed disease; or
- where the MS or zone, or compartment, has obtained disease—
 free status:
 - take one or more of the measures laid down for A category disease proportionate to the risk posed by the listed disease in question, and
 - where necessary, initiate the compulsory eradication programme for that listed disease.



Regulation (EU) 2016/429 - control measures



Category C

- MS that has opted for an eradication programme shall apply the disease control measures laid down in the optional eradication programme
- The CA may decide to take one or more of the measures laid down for A category disease proportionate to the risk posed by the listed disease in question
- MS, zone or compartment that has obtained disease—free status shall take one or more of the measures laid down for category A disease. Those measures shall be proportionate to the risk posed by the listed disease in question
- The similar control measures apply for Category B and C for wild animals
- The MS should inform the Commission in respect of the measures they are undertaking
