General overview



- The funding of the AH measures is to reduce the presence of animal diseases and zoonosis which pose risk to human or animal health or major economic disruption
- Specific measures are co-funded trough
 - National Veterinary Programmes
 - Emergency measures



National veterinary programmes



- Annual or multiannual for disease listed in Annex II of Regulation 652/2014, that are:
 - threat to human health
 - threat to animals and trade
 - scientific purposes
- There are three types of Vet. Programmes
 - Eradication programmes
 - Control programmes
 - Surveillance programmes



Emergency measures



- In case of occurrence of a disease listed in Annex I of Regulation 652/2014, that have significant impact on:
 - human health
 - animal health and welfare
 - agricultural production or related sectors of economy



Regulation Community Funding



Management of the veterinary expenditures are regulated with Regulation 652/2014

Step 1 - request



- confirmation of case of disease
- 1 month after, MS should send preliminary information on the estimation of the costs
- ongoing and future actions





- confirmation of case of disease
- 2 months after, MS should send estimate cost for compensation, operational costs, update of the situation and exceptional cost
- update every 2 months



Step 3 - financing decision



- COMM adopts financing decision
- Defining the financial conditions
- Eligible costs
- Fixing EU maximum potential contribution



Step 4 - payment application



- 6 months after end date of eradication, MS submits request for payment
- Technical and
- Financial report



Step 5 - application assessment

- COMM assesses the application
- The eligibility of the costs
- Additional documentation
- Ex-ante, on the spot check is possible



Step 6 - validation of expenditures



COMM reaches final decision on eligibility of the costs and informs the MS



Step 7 - payment



- 3 month after payment application the COMM reimburses the MS
- Deadline can be prolonged in case of controls



General criteria for eligible cost



- Incurred in the period of Decision,
- Indicated in the preliminary budget
- Incurred in relation of actions described in the Decision
- Identifiable and verifiable
- Comply with the taxation and social legislation rules
- Comply to sound finical management
- Covered before the application for payment



Categories of eligible cost



- Compensation to the owner for animals and products
- Slaughtering or culling
- Cleaning, dis-insectization and disinfection
- Transport and destruction of carcasses, feed and equipment
- Vaccine purchase and application
- Exceptional and duly justified cases



Compensation to the owners



• For animals

- evaluated visual inspection
- each animal individually, in case of poultry or pigs in group
- correspond to the market value
- amount claimed/number of animals
- deducted the salvage value
- maximum limit + 20%
- outbreak and preventive slaughter, died after official confirmation
- no further losses earnings are eligible



Compensation to the owners



- For products
 - milk, meat and products thereof, eggs, semen and embryos
 - individually evaluated



Other compensation



- Slaughtering and culling
- Cleaning, dis-insectization and disinfection
- Transport and destruction of feed and equipment
- Vaccination
- Transport and disposal of carcasses
- Overhead of 7%
- Essential
 - laboratory test,
 - sampling
 - information of dead animal,
 - burial of dead animal,
 - awareness campaigns,

as for ASF

Ineligible costs



- Voluntary culling or destruction of products
- Evaluation fees
- Cost out of the scope of decision
- Allowance
- Training
- Repairs
- Depreciation
- Water
- Police, army, fire fighters, municipality staff



Reimbursement




- Cost in the scope of decision
- Identifiable and verifiable
- Proof of payment
- Records on official evaluation
- Bills
- Invoices
- Procurement documents
- I&R documentation and records
- Official documentation connected to the outbreak/s and before outbreaks
- Attestations/claims for the actions
- Before the application for reimbursement

Third country support



- In accordance with the Article 6 paragraph 2 and 5 of the Regulation 2014/652, grants ay be awarded to a third country incase of direct threat to the Union
- Submit application with preliminary estimate
- Assessment
- Sing agreement
- Annex forms and report
- The rules for eligibility
- The rules for identification and verification of cost
