## IMPLEMENT THE FOLLOWING MEASURES

- OBSERVE THE INSTRUCTION PROVIDED BY THE 'VETERINARY SERVICE'
- RESTRICT ALL MOVEMENT OF THE ANIMALS ON THE FARM
- LIMIT THE MOVEMENT OF ANIMALS AND STAFF ON THE FARM
- ENSURE ALL VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT THAT MUST LEAVE THE FARM ARE CLEANED AND DISINFECTED
- COLLECT ALL THE DATA RELATED TO THE ANIMALS
- KEEP STAFF AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS INFORMED
- ISOLATE THE SUSPECTED ANIMALS IN A SECURE LOCATION
